FRANK C. SMITH

Frank C. Smith was an employee of Getchell enterprises in Midas. He lived and practiced his trade on Main Street (200 Block, West Side) and also worked at the lab at the Elko Prince Mine. Their daughter, the Distinquished Nevadan Frances Smith Crumley, was away at school when her parents lived in Midas in the very early 30s.

DOOR SIGNS

This door was salvaged from Bill Vest's bar which was operating in the mid fifties. Lucky Lager was a popular beer and the Old Gold Tobacco Company was offering a "treat instead of a treatment". This same bar had a sign on one of its other doors proclaiming; "No Minors Aloud." Vest's Bar was located on property now owned by Pam Mortara and family. The door is now the front entrance to the fuel supply shop.



COMMISSARY

A very large, two story building occupied this location and was the commissary for the Gold And Silver Mining Co. Getchell's home was just to the north across Second Street and many of Getchell's guests including world boxing champ, Jack Dempsey and the Governors of Nevada and California stayed in one of these two places. This property is now owned and frequently occupied by Skip and Dorry Powell.
